Many children who receive free and reduced priced school meals are left without the nutrition they need on weekends and holiday breaks when school is not in session. By providing children who are at risk of hunger with a bag of nutritious food each Friday throughout the school year, the *Backpack Snack Attack* Program attempts to reduce this gap and help children return to school on Monday ready to learn.

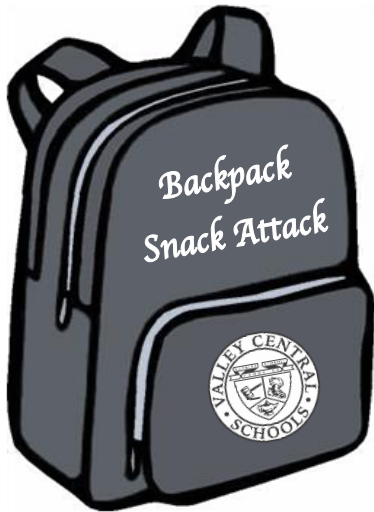
The *Backpack Snack Attack* program is a non-profit organization run by the First Reformed Church of Walden. This meal program provides bags of food to hungry children on the weekend.

Because it costs about \$25,000 in food and monetary donations annually to provide the bags, the program relies on generous donations from community members and constant fundraising efforts of the BPSA supporters. All funds contributed go directly to the purchase of food for over 100 Valley Central Students.

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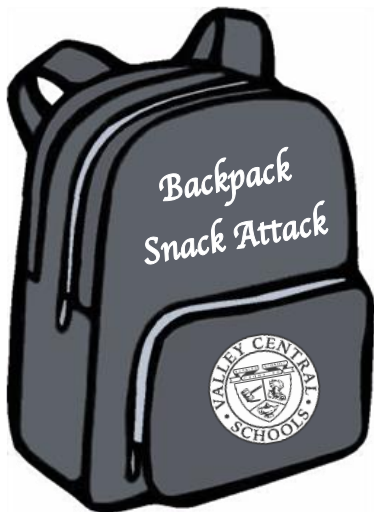
